

2009 DAYTON ALL*STAR QUALIFIERS

FORMAT: The Dayton All*Star team will consist of a total 28 men and 15 women who will be determined by qualifying scores. The top 24 men & 12 women are guaranteed a spot on one of the 6 men's or 3 women's teams. The remaining players are alternates and will be utilized as needed. There teams will compete against other teams from Cincinnati, Columbus & Cleveland in the Quad-City Challenge Sunday November 22, 2009.

ELIGIBILITY: Anyone may attempt to qualify, but to be an official member of the Dayton All*Star team & receive advertised team benefits (shirts, hotel and singles event compensation), they must be a DDA member. DDA fees are \$15.00 and must be paid in full prior to 11pm on Saturday October 17, 2009. There are no exceptions!

QUALIFYING:

1. The qualifying score used for determining the All*Star team is the sum of 3 legs for a given qualifying attempt. Each of these legs are on a single side of a qualifying sheet. A leg from a different score sheet or from the opposite side of the same score sheet may not be used to calculate the qualifying score.
2. Qualifying fees are as follows: \$3.00 for 1 attempt or \$5.00 for 2 attempts. Fees must be paid before the darter begins any qualifying attempt(s). The number of attempts a darter would like to make must be decided & paid for up front. No one will be allowed to pay \$3 for 1 attempt and then decide later to make a second attempt for \$2. Each attempt consists of 3 legs and are on 1 side of a qualifying score sheet. All fees paid are non-refundable and non-transferable. No Credit will be extended.
3. The darter may warm up before starting each leg of a qualifying attempt. The darter must inform the scorekeeper when they are ready to begin each leg prior to throwing the first dart of that leg. Once the first leg has begun, all three legs must be completed without break. All Scores must be verified by scorekeeper (or a DDA Board member) before darts are pulled from the board. If there is no verification, the scorekeeper will list that round as a zero (0) score.
4. Each leg of a qualifier consists of a total of 16 rounds for a given leg. Once a leg is started, all darts thrown count in succession as the 16 rounds for a given leg. The sum of all 16 rounds counts as the score for a given leg. The 16 rounds for a leg will be thrown in the following order:
 - a. 10 (ten) rounds of score, which may be thrown at any segment on the board and count as face value.
 - b. 6 (six) rounds at specific doubles in order: 20, 16, 10, 8, 2 & 1. Each correct double hit counts as 40 points toward the leg score regardless of the face value of the segment.
5. All bounce-outs or robin-hoods are darts that **can be re-thrown**. They are to be re-thrown after the third dart of a round is thrown.
6. Of someone gives up during a qualifying attempt, that leg and therefore, the entire attempt is unfinished and **may not be resumed** later. The score sheet will be marked D.N.F. for the leg and the overall qualifying score will be recorded a D.N.F.

Scheduled Qualifiers:

1. There are no open qualifiers. All qualifying attempts must be taken on one of the scheduled dates, times and locations noted on the qualifier schedule.
2. Qualifiers will begin at 2:00pm on Saturdays & 7:00pm on any week night scheduled. Sign-ups will close at 11:00pm on Saturdays & 9:00pm on the week nights. There will be no exceptions. On the final Saturday you must purchase all score sheets you wish to attempt to qualify before 11:00pm. No more attempts will be sold after this time.
3. Anyone who purchased score sheets prior to the closing time may stay until they have thrown as many qualifying attempts as were paid for. A properly paid for score sheet will have the darter's name and the \$3 or \$5 purchase price written on it by the DDA board member running the qualifying for the night.

2. An All*Star team coach will be appointed by the All*Star committee no later than October 20, 2009. Along with the All*Star committee, the coach will assemble teams, appoint captains and schedule practices.
3. There must be at least 2 DDA board members present at all scheduled qualifiers.
4. All members of the 2009 All*Star team should plan on being at the tournament no later than 10am the morning of Sunday November 22, 2009.

DAYTON ALL*STAR QUALIFIERS

FORMAT: THE DAYTON ALL*STAR TEAM WILL CONSIST OF 28 MEN AND 15 WOMEN. QUALIFIERS WILL DETERMINE THE 28 MEN AND 15 WOMEN. THE QUALIFYING SCORE WILL BE THE TOTAL OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S 3 SCORES ON ONE SHEET.

QUALIFYING:

1. THERE IS A FEE OF \$3.00 PER ATTEMPT (ONE SHEET, ONE SIDE) OR \$5.00 FOR 2 ATTEMPTS (ONE SHEET, BOTH SIDES). THE MONEY MUST BE COLLECTED BEFORE THE DARTER THROWS.
2. THE DDA BOARD MEMBER TAKING THE MONEY FROM THE DARTER WILL WRITE THE DARTER'S NAME ON THE SCORE SHEET AND INDICATE WHETHER THEY PAID \$3 OR \$5. NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO ATTEMPT TO QUALIFY WITHOUT A SCORE SHEET PAID FOR IN ADVANCE. DO NOT EXTEND CREDIT. ALL FEES PAID ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE.
3. THE PERSON QUALIFYING MAY WARM UP BEFORE THEY START THE QUALIFIER. THE DARTER MUST TELL YOU THAT THEY ARE STARTING BEFORE THROWING THEIR FIRST DART. EXAMPLE: SOMEONE WARMING UP AND THROWS ONE OR MORE DARTS CAN'T SAY THAT WAS THEIR FIRST THROW.
4. ALL BOUNCE-OUTS OR ROBIN-HOODS ARE TO BE RE-THROWN AFTER THE 3RD DART OF A ROUND IS THROWN.
5. WHENEVER A PLAYER GIVES UP DURING A QUALIFIER, MARK THE SCORE SHEET AS D.N.F. ONCE A PLAYER GIVES UP, THEY CAN'T CONTINUE THAT ATTEMPT LATER.
6. IF SOMEONE IS NOT A DDA MEMBER, THEY MUST PAY THE \$15.00 DDA MEMBERSHIP FEE BEFORE 11pm THE LAST NIGHT OF QUALIFYING.

SCHEDULED QUALIFIERS:

1. THERE ARE NO OPEN QUALIFIERS. ALL QUALIFIERS MUST BE TAKEN ON THE DATES/TIMES/LOCATIONS NOTED ON THE QUALIFYING SCHEDULE.
2. ALL QUALIFIERS WILL BEGIN AT 2pm ON SATURDAYS AND 7pm ON A WEEK NIGHT. SIGN-UP CLOSES AT 11pm ON SATURDAY AND 9pm ON A WEEK NIGHT.
3. ANYONE WHO SIGNED UP PRIOR TO CLOSING CAN STAY UNTIL THEY HAVE THROWN FOR AS MANY ATTEMPTS AS WERE PAID FOR.
4. THERE MUST BE AT LEAST 2 DDA BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT AT EVERY QUALIFIERS.
5. IF IT GETS TOO BUSY FOR 2 MEMBERS, CALL ANY DDA ALL*STAR COMMITTEE MEMBER TO ARRANGE ASSISTANCE.

ALL*STAR TEAM FORMAT:

1. THE MEN'S TEAM WILL CONSIST OF 6 TEAMS OF 4 MEMBERS WITH 4 ALTERNATES. A COACH WILL BE CHOSEN BY THE ALL*STAR COMMITTEE NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 20, 2009. THE ALL*STAR COMMITTEE WILL NOTIFY THE COACH AND SUPPLY HIM/HER WITH A TEAM LIST (INCLUDING PHONE NUMBERS). IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COACH TO CONTACT ALL PLAYERS ON THE TEAM AND INFORM THEM OF THE SCHEDULED PRACTICES.
2. THE WOMEN'S TEAM WILL CONSIST OF 3 TEAMS OF 5 MEMBERS. 4 MAY PLAY AT ONE TIME. A TEAM CAPTAIN WILL BE CHOSEN FOR EACH TEAM BY THE ALL*STAR COMMITTEE AND TEAM COACH.
3. THE ALL*STAR COMMITTEE WILL SET 3 SEPARATE DAYS FOR PRACTICE. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COACH AND TEAM CAPTAINS TO MAKE SURE ALL TEAM MEMBERS KNOW OF THESE DATES AND REQUEST THEIR PRESENCE. GETTING THE 4(5) PERSON TEAMS TO PRACTICE OFTEN WILL ALLOW THEM TO MESH BETTER AT THE CHALLENGE.

BOARD MEMBER'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. THERE IS NO NEED TO CALL IN THE SCORES.
2. CIRCLE ANY TON-80'S SHOT
3. ALL SCORE SHEETS WILL BE COLLECTED AT THE END OF EACH QUALIFIER BY THE ALL*STAR SECRETARY WHO WILL VERIFY THE CORRECTNESS OF EACH SCORE. IF THE SECRETARY IS NOT AVAILABLE, THE SENIOR COMMITTEE/BOARD MEMBER SHOULD COLLECT THEM.. THE MONEY COLLECTED SHOULD BE VERIFIED THAT IT MEETS WITH THE SCORE SHEETS COLLECTED. AFTER VERIFIED, THE MONEY SHOULD BE HELD BY THE SENIOR COMMITTEE/BOARD MEMBER PRESENT AND SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THE DDA BOARD TREASURER.
4. ALL*STAR STANDING WILL BE UPDATED WEEKLY BY THE ALL*STAR SECRETARY AND DISTRIBUTED TO THE DDA SECRETARY AND THE WEB MASTER.
